Our Services

Overhaul, draught proofing and new window furniture

This service gives your existing traditional windows a new lease of life as we sympathetically overhaul all the working elements of the window:

- All sash cords replaced
- The counter weight system rebalanced
- New window furniture and security locks added
- Draught proofing installed

Our draught proofing procedure eliminates draughts, while not impacting on the traditional look of the windows. We can also carry out any other remedial work such as re-glazing and repairing rotten wood or perished putty.

Replacement sashes

Here we replace the moving parts of the window (sashes), which are custom-made and fully double-glazed. They not only fit with the period detail of your property, they also offer you all the benefits of modern double-glazing:


- Existing sashes replaced with our custom-made double-glazed sashes

- The old window frame remains in place


Full window replacement

Secondary Glazing

Our secondary glazing will provide you with maximum sound insulation but, importantly has very little impact on the look of your windows.

What is secondary glazing?

Secondary glazing is a fully independent frame fitted on the room side of an existing window to form a double window or 'double glazing'.

We use a system that has been tried and tested for over 40 years. What's more, our secondary glazing can be made with wooden frames and painted to suit your chosen interior styling.

Why use secondary glazing?

While the main benefit is to reduce noise pollution to an absolute minimum, secondary glazing will also help you conserve energy and improve your home's security. As it does not affect the character of your building, it satisfies Heritage and Conservation bodies if you live in a listed building.
